REFLECT

In the time between his resurrection and his return to heaven, Jesus spoke clearly about how his believers were to live until his second coming.

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."—Acts 1:8

What are the gifts or experiences that enable you to be an effective witness where you are? We often think of missionaries as those who travel long distances to share God's love, but it is possible that you are called to people who simply live across the street. You may be separated by music taste, language, culture or even misconceptions about God, but you are called to bridge the gap in your own unique way.

RESPOND

Once you recognize that you have been granted gifts that God can use to unlock the hearts of those who do not know him yet, the challenge is to identify and begin using your gifts for his glory. Ask the Holy Spirit to identify individuals, communities, or even entire cultures that he wants you to serve.

"You are the light of the world—like a city on a hilltop that cannot be hidden. In the same way, let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father."

In every situation, you can trust that God will lead and empower you to be like a city on a hill as you shine your light.
