REFLECT

What are some of the things that distract you from experiencing an abundant life in God?
What are some of the spiritual practices that keep you rooted in God?

The life God offers is dependent on him. He allows every season to be one of growth and every day to be one in which you can be fruitful and flourish.

“...I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who remain in me, and I in them, will produce much fruit. For apart from me you can do nothing.” -John 15:5

Just as good fruit on a vine's branches is the result of the nourishment that flows from the vine, your fruit is a result of Jesus' life flowing through you. People in your circle of influence are drawn to this fruit.

RESPOND

How would your life and leadership change if you shifted your focus away from the future and instead committed to flourishing in the day God has given you today?

Today, God has given you opportunities to glorify him. Today he has words of wisdom and encouragement to share with you. Today is a day he has designed for you to thrive and to be transformed.

Some days are more challenging than others, but today will never come again. Today, your connection and reliance on God can produce growth, maturity, joy, and spiritual fruit.

REVIEW
